Calder Foot – Jumbles Beat

The lower of the two Ribble beats that form part of the Stonyhurst Estate water, which we have leased since 1964.

This beat is approximately three quarters of a mile right bank including the with the junction pool of the Calder and Ribble at its upper limit and runs to the limit boundary with the Cross Gills Beat. The rest of the beat is a series of pools (Island Pool, Brockhole, Jumbles and Pea Scar) and riffles with a small set of falls Jumbles Falls, at the lower end.

It is a beat that has the charm of low water as well as the exciting prospects in high water.

The majority of the beat is open and with the pools and riffles is excellent water for fly and spinner, ideally a small rise of water provides the best opportunities. Fish will push up through this beat, even on low water and rest up in the deeper holes.
