

Hodder Foot – Calder Foot Beat

The upper of the two Ribble beats that form part of the Stonyhurst Estate water, which we have leased since 1964

This beat is approximately three quarters of a mile right bank including the junction pool of the Hodder and Ribble at its upper limit and runs to the start of Calder Foot Pool. Below Hodder Foot is a section of streamy broken water, ideal for trout and sea trout, before entering a long pool called Kelts Parlour, which consists of a run into the pool and a long steady draw through the pool. The tail run into the head of Calder Foot pool.
