

Hothersall Beat

This leased beat is just over one and a quarter miles in length and comprises of a number of pools and runs with a number of recognised salmon taking spots. Sea trout are found in the streamier sections even in low water. There is also a good head of coarse fish and grayling, which our members are usually fish for during the close season. All methods are allowed on this beat, but fly fishing is best when there is a little rise in water level.



Island Pool

At the top of the beat is an island pool which fishes well for salmon and towards the tail of the pool there are good holding spots for sea trout.



Following that is another longish pool with a shallower run, which again fishes best for salmon when there is water.

Fish tending to lie towards the far bank.

Adjacent to the bank side car park there is another noted spot for both salmon and sea trout, whilst the run down from the car park is streamier and holds good number of trout and sea trout.

The long pool at the bottom of the beat deepens slowly to provide a number of spots where migrating fish lie up.
